John Hall selected 2 Peter 1: 15 as his text with these words: Moreover, I will endeavor that ye may be able, after my decease, to have these things always in remembrance. Having carried on a correspondence with Alexander for forty years there was no one better suited to the task than Hall, and he did not disappoint. Reading this sermon will stir up the soul of every true child of God, but will especially challenge ministers of the Gospel to spend and be spent in the service of their Master.
